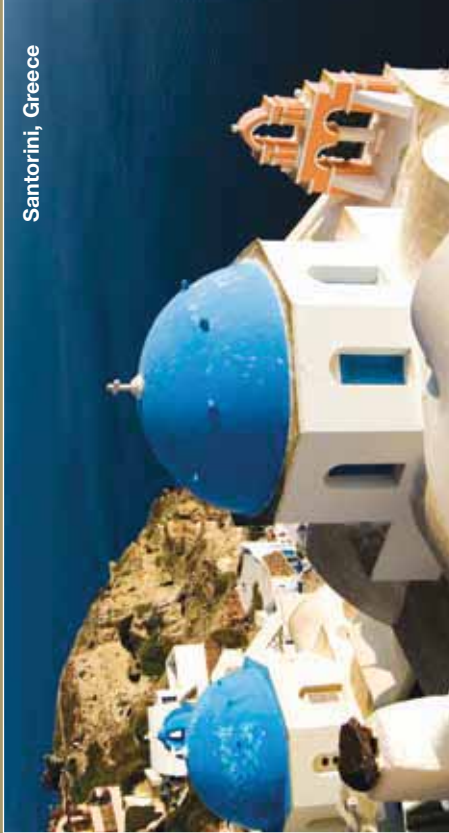

VENICE, ITALY Savor the majestic beauty of this amazing city as you glide along its canals, under bridges, and past opulent palazzi and elegant churches. DELOS, GREECE Stroll through the amazing remnants of ancient temples on this uninhabited island, a much revered sanctuary of antiquity. Silent marble lions still stand guard at the legendary birthplace of Apollo, where the temples' splendid mosaic floors are a sight to behold.

MYKONOS, GREECE Wander through the winding streets of this lovely seaside village. Discover a kaleidoscope of whitewashed houses, flowers, and brightly painted shutters and doors. Stand beneath the windmills on the hill, take in the fascinating Archaeological Museum, or visit an old bakery still using a 15th-century wood-burning stove.
