Rapidly expanding yet holding true to its roots, the city of Dublin offers a wide array of compelling attractions. A UNESCO City of Literature, Dublin was once home and inspiration to renowned writers W.B. Yeats, Oscar Wilde, Samuel Beckett, and many others. Georgian-style houses line spacious streets, friendly pubs welcome you in with their unique character, and tokens of history lie in wait of discovery across this compact, vivacious city.

June 25 Disembark *Sirena* and set out on a full-day sightseeing tour of Dublin. Begin at Trinity College, the oldest university in Ireland, and visit the Old Library to see the Book of Kells. A ninth-century illuminated manuscript, the Book of Kells is intricately detailed with vibrant colors created from crushed pearls, beetles' wings, and other organic matter. Stop at St. Patrick's Cathedral, the burial site of Jonathan Swift, before driving to Merrion Square, home to the famous lounging statue of Oscar Wilde. After lunch on your own, head to the Guinness Storehouse, a museum that demonstrates the brewing process and shares the history of the Guinness family and franchise. Tour the facility, sip a complimentary stout, and take in the city's sights from the top floor, which offers an unparalleled vantage point. Transfer to the four-star Trinity City Hotel and spend the remainder of the day at leisure.

June 26 After breakfast, set out on a full-day sightseeing tour south of Dublin. Begin with a walking tour of Glendalough, "Valley of Two Lakes." Founded in the sixth century, Glendalough is an early medieval monastic settlement. Stroll through the peaceful footpaths and take in the old stone monuments like Reefert Church, The Round Tower, and The Gateway, one of the most distinctive monuments of Glendalough. Next, drive to Wicklow Town, believed to have been founded by Vikings in AD 795. Take in views of the harbor and dine at a local café or restaurant during free time before driving to the Powerscourt Estate, which overlooks Great Sugarloaf Mountain. Located in the charming town of Enniskerry, the sprawling forty-seven acre Powerscourt House & Gardens is home to Ireland's tallest waterfall, numerous opportunities for shopping, and small cafés and restaurants.

June 27 Transfer to the airport* for your return flight home.

This tour involves a moderate amount of walking, some over uneven or uphill terrain, and may not be suitable for those with walking difficulties. Local customs require the covering of knees and shoulders at religious sites.
