Afterward, satisfy your appetite at the renowned Wicklow Heather, where lunch awaits you.

As the day continues, immerse yourself in the grandeur of Powerscourt House & Gardens. Stroll through the opulent estate, and marvel at the intricately designed terraces. As the tour comes to an end, transfer back to your hotel to enjoy your evening.
