ITINERARY

- July 26 Disembark *Marina* and set out on a half-day excursion of Copenhagen. See the Changing the Guard ceremony (schedule permitting) at Amalienborg Palace, a private residence of the royal family, and pass by Christiansborg Palace, the seat of the Danish parliament. You will also see the charming and colorful old harbor of Nyhavn, among other popular sights, before visiting beautiful Rosenborg Castle, home to the crown jewels. At tour conclusion, transfer to the 4-star Imperial Hotel Copenhagen and enjoy the remainder of the day at your leisure.
- **July 27** This morning, set out on a five-hour excursion, through farmland and small villages, to tour some of Roskilde's most prominent attractions. Explore the Viking Ship Museum, which contains the remains of five Viking vessels salvaged from the bottom of the Roskilde Fjord. Afterward, travel to the town square to visit Roskilde Cathedral. Constructed during the twelfth century, the twin-spired structure is the burial place of more than forty Danish monarchs, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and was the first cathedral to be built from brick—inspiring the spread of brick-Gothic architecture throughout northern Europe.
- **July 28** After breakfast, transfer to the airport* for your return flight home.

Note: These tours involve a moderate amount of walking, some over uneven terrain and may not be suitable for those with walking difficulties. The order of tours may vary.
