ITINERARY

August 10 Disembark *Sirena* in Oslo and enjoy a half-day panoramic tour of beautiful Oslo after you visit the capitol building of Norway, Oslo City Hall. Stroll along the boardwalk of Aker Brygge, the city's lively waterfront shopping and entertainment area. Enjoy seeing the site of the yearly Nobel Peace Prize ceremony, followed by the rest of what Oslo has to offer: the medieval Akershus Fortress, the neoclassical Royal Palace, the Parliament building, the National Theatre, the Opera House, and the Norwegian Nobel Institute.

Stop at Vigeland Park, which draws visitors worldwide with more than two hundred unique granite and bronze statues crafted by Norwegian sculptor Gustav Vigeland. Meander through the picturesque park and admire the collection's most prominent sculptures, from the awe-inspiring forty-six-foot-high Monolith—believed to be the world's largest granite sculpture—to the much-photographed Sinnataggen (Angry Boy). Continue to the iconic Holmenkollen Ski Jump, an engineering marvel offering exceptional views across the city and its glistening fjord. Transfer to Clarion the Hub and enjoy the rest of the evening at your leisure.

August 11 After breakfast, head out for a half-day journey along Bygdøy peninsula. Visit the Fram Museum, learn about Norway's polar exploration. Experience the cold and the dangers of expeditions more than 100 years ago in the polar simulator before continuing to the Kon-Tiki Museum. Explore this renowned museum with its variety of vessels and artifacts from legendary Norwegian adventurer and anthropologist Thor Heyerdahl, including the balsa raft Kon-Tiki, which he used to cross the Pacific Ocean from Peru to Polynesia in 1947, and the reed boat Ra II.

August 12 After breakfast, transfer to the airport* for your return flight home.

Note: These tours involve a moderate amount of walking, some over uneven terrain and may not be suitable for those with walking difficulties. The order of tours may vary.
