ITINERARY

April 2 Disembark *Sirena* and enjoy an exciting half-day sightseeing tour of Panama City. Embark on a walking tour of historic Casco Viejo, Panama's hippest neighborhood. See historic buildings and important plazas that played a significant role in Panama's colonial history. Then, revel in a cup of Geisha Panamanian Coffee and learn why Geisha beans are among the most popular in the world. Stop at La Cuadra to grab lunch on your own. Experience a full view of the Miraflores Locks operation before transferring to Gamboa Rainforest Resort in the afternoon.

April 3 Explore life in a natural environment on a full day tour of Emberá Querá Village. Your adventure begins with a half-hour ride to the most pristine tropical forest in a traditional Embera canoe up Gatón River. Immerse yourself in Embera culture through indigenous music, dance, and art. Visit their habitual residences and the tribal shaman and learn about the healing power of plants of the jungle. Shop for local crafts and indulge in the "catch of the day" for lunch.

April 4 After breakfast, transfer to the airport to return home.

Note: These tours involve a moderate amount of walking, some over uneven terrain, and may not be suitable for those with walking difficulties. Must be able to enter and exit a traditional canoe for a 30-minute transfer to Embera village.

GAMBOA RAINFOREST RESORT

Surrounded by wooded vegetation, the Gamboa Rainforest Resort is located next to the Chagres River. Watch for turquoise butterflies, colorful toucans, or emerald lizards poking around. The rooms are spacious and feature free Wi-Fi, a flat-screen TV, a coffee maker, and a balcony with views of the river or greenery. Relax at the tropical style pool and enjoy fresh, seasonal cuisine at one of the hotel's three on-site dining options.
