April 10

Arrive at Haneda Airport and transfer* to the four-star Keio Plaza Hotel or similar accommodations. Spend the remainder of the day at leisure

April 11

The adventure continues with a picturesque drive to Hakone, where you'll ascend Mount Komagatake via a Mount Komagatake Ropeway gondola, providing a 7-minute spectacle of Mount Fuji, Lake Ashi, Mount Futago, and the distant Izu Peninsula. Explore the summit's Hakone Mototsumiya-jinja Shrine and enjoy a leisurely lunch in the Hakone area. The day culminates with a serene boat cruise across Lake Ashi, ensuring a perfect blend of nature and culture.

April 12
