ITINERARY

May 26

Disembark *Insignia* and begin a half-day excursion on a journey to one of the world's most iconic and enigmatic landmarks -Stonehenge. May 27

After breakfast, enjoy a panoramic drive through London. See famous attractions and landmarks, then head to the Tower of London, a UNESCO World Heritage site and home to the Crown Jewels and legendary Beefeaters, dressed in their traditional Tudor uniforms. The city's history comes to life at this nine-hundredyear-old fortress that has served as a royal palace and infamous prison.
