#### **ITINERARY**

#### **April 24**

Disembark *Insignia* and enjoy an exciting half-day sightseeing tour of Panama City. Embark on a walking tour of historic Casco Viejo, Panama's hippest neighborhood. See historic buildings and important plazas that played a significant role in Panama's colonial history. Then, revel in a cup of Geisha Panamanian Coffee and learn why Geisha beans are among the most popular in the world. Head to the Central Panama Hotel in the afternoon and spend the remainder of the day at your leisure.

## **April 25**

Explore life in a natural environment on a full-day tour of Emberá Querá Village. Your adventure begins with a half-hour ride through the most pristine tropical forest in a traditional Embera canoe up the Gatun River. Immerse yourself in Embera culture through indigenous music, dance, and art. Visit their habitual residences and the tribal shaman, and learn about the healing power of jungle plants. Shop for local crafts and indulge in the "catch of the day" for lunch.

After lunch, continue to the Miraflores Visitor Center for a frontrow view of one of the world's great engineering marvels—the
Panama Canal Locks. From the viewing platform, you'll have a
chance to witness a ship transit the canal (if you're lucky!) and
capture incredible photos. Your visit includes entrance to the
IMAX Theater to experience a dynamic 3D film—narrated by
Morgan Freeman—that brings to life the epic history,
construction, and ongoing operations of the Panama Canal.
After this unforgettable day, return to your hotel.

**April 26** After breakfast, transfer to the airport to return home.
