ITINERARY

May 21

Arrive in Paris and transfer to the Pullman Paris Montparnasse. Spend the remainder of the day at leisure, exploring the City of Light at your own pace. Stroll iconic boulevards, relax in charming cafés, and take in the city's timeless beauty.

May 22

After breakfast, embark on a full-day journey from Paris to Le Havre. Along the way, visit Monet's house and gardens in Giverny, where the famed impressionist painted his masterpieces. Wander through lush landscapes and vibrant blooms that inspired a revolution in art.

May 23

After breakfast, set out on a full-day tour of Normandy's historic sites. Visit Omaha and Utah Beaches, the Normandy American Cemetery and Memorial, and Point du Hoc. Explore the immersive D-Day Experience museum in Saint-Côme-du-Mont, where history comes alive through powerful exhibits and storytelling.

May 24

After breakfast, enjoy a half-day tour of Le Havre, a city reborn through the visionary architecture of Auguste Perret. Discover the striking St. Joseph Church and the modernist Niemeyer Library. Then, transfer to the port of Le Havre to embark on your English Channel Discovery cruise aboard your ship.
