ITINERARY

May 9

Disembark Emerald Kaia and set out on a full-day tour of the neighboring islands of Murano and Burano. Begin your adventure with a scenic boat ride, followed by an immersive glass-blowing experience in Murano, where you'll learn the ancient art firsthand. In Burano, stroll through the picturesque streets and visit workshops producing some of the finest lace in Europe. Enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant before you check in at the 4-star Hotel Papadopoli Venezia. Spend the remainder of the day at leisure.

May 10

After breakfast, set out on an inspiring half-day tour of Venice. Peruse the ornate exterior of Scuola Grande di San Rocco, noted for the finest works of the Renaissance painter Tintoretto. From Venice's Ca' Foscari University you have spectacular views of the famous Rialto Bridge and Accademia Bridge. Immerse yourself in the Venice tradition of carnival mask making at a traditional mask shop before taking a relaxing stroll across the Accademia Bridge into Campo Santo Stefano-a popular city square. Then, enjoy one of the finest Italian theaters as you take in the beauty of Teatro la Fenice.

May 11

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight home.



Mobility Requirement: Travelers should be confident in their ability to walk and stand for up to 3-4 hours with a total of up to 2 miles per day while keeping a steady pace with a group or tour guide. This tour can involve walking on mostly uneven ground and occasionally stairs, some with no handrails. Travelers should be able to board a coach or tour bus independently. This tour is not recommended for those with a walker or wheelchair. Must be able to enter/exit the motor launch for water taxi transfer and cross canal bridges via steps. Local customs require covering knees and shoulders when visiting religious sites.
