ITINERARY

May 13

Disembark Sirena, and set out on a half-day sightseeing excursion that highlights some of Rome's most celebrated attractions. Begin with a tour of Papal Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls, an impressive church that houses the tomb of Saint Paul. Immerse yourself in its spiritual ambiance and admire the stunning mosaics that adorn its walls. Afterward, continue on the Ostiense Road, past the Pyramid of Caius Cestius, St. Paul's Gate, the Baths of Caracalla and the Circus Maximus, the site of ancient chariot races. Next enjoy and interior visit of the Colosseum, one of the world's most iconic landmarks. As you stroll around, you'll be transported back in time to the days of the gladiator battles and spectacles. Next, walk past the Roman Forum, a sprawling archaeological site that was once the center of political and social life in ancient Rome. Transfer to the Metropole Hotel and spend the rest of the day at your leisure.

May 14

After breakfast, set out on an exciting tour of Vatican City, the smallest city-state in the world. Explore the vast collection of art and glorious treasures in the Vatican Museums, marvel at the Sistine Chapel's breathtaking ceiling, and admire the largest church in the world, the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica. Those who do not join in the optional excursion will spend the afternoon at leisure.

OPTIONAL: Tivoli & Villa d'Este Excursion, \$179 per person Travel beyond the bustle of Rome to explore Tivoli, known for its Villa d'Este— a captivating garden complex. Once a Benedictine monastery and now a UNESCO World Heritage site, the villa is adorned with impressive waterfalls and more than five hundred fountains.

May 15

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight home.
