KOJ-001 HIGHLIGHTS OF KAGOSHIMA

OVERVIEW

Discover the natural beauty and flora surrounding Kagoshima with a special emphasis on the wonders of the active volcano Mount Sakurajima. The volcano constantly emits smoke and ash, at times thousands of feet into the air. You will enjoy an excellent view of the volcanic activity while riding a ferry across the bay to the Arimura Lava Observatory, where the view will be even more spectacular. The observatory sits atop a hilly lava field that a 1946 eruption created. Back in Kagoshima, you will pause at Sengan-en Garden, a botanical oasis built to complement the 17th-century residence of one of Japan's most influential feudal lords. It couldn't be lovelier, especially with majestic Mount Sakurajima towering in the background. For a glimpse into Kagoshima's industrial history, you will browse the Shoko Shuseikan Museum, which holds a collection of items from one of Japan's earliest machinery factories.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Admire the still-active volcano Mount Sakurajima while riding a ferry across the bay.
- Enjoy an even closer look at the volcano from an observatory on an old lava field.
- See the 17th-century home and garden of the powerful Shimazu clan.
- Browse museum exhibits that depict Kagoshima's earliest efforts to industrialize.

- Wear flat comfortable walking shoes.

KOJ-004 CHIRAN & IBUSUKI

OVERVIEW

Stroll through a historical neighborhood where samurais once lived and admire the natural beauty throughout the Kagoshima prefecture. Upon reaching the castle-town of Chiran, you will walk down a lane lined with stone walls, behind which lie a number of centuries-old samurai houses that recapture the essence of the Edo Period. Samurai descendants still inhabit some of the estates, although the gardens of other residences are open for browsing. Another beautiful setting awaits you at Cape Nagasakibana, the southernmost point on the Satsuma Peninsula, where you will enjoy outstanding panoramic views of Mt. Kaimon. It is often compared to Mt. Fuji because it too features a nearly perfect conical-shaped top. Nearby, you will find the hot springs resort of Ibusuki and Lake Ikeda, a crater lake that formed in a collapsed volcano.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Marvel at the meticulously restored samurai houses in the castle town of Chiran.
- Drive through the immensely picturesque Satsuma Peninsula, taking in the panoramas.

- Behold the beauty of Mt. Kaimon, which looks remarkably similar to famed Mt. Fuji.
- See the island's largest volcanic lake, supposedly the home of a Loch Ness-type monster.

KOJ-003 CHIRAN DISCOVERY

OVERVIEW

Explore Chiran, an out-lying castle town during Japan's feudal period and home base for the feared kamikaze pilots during World War II. Departing the port, take a scenic drive to Chiran to see the well-preserved residences and gardens of the Samurai. Surrounded by moss-covered stonewalls and sporting black tile roofs, the 250 year old houses recapture the traditional flavor of the Edo Period. Today, Samurai descendants live some of the old estates, but many of the gardens are open to the public. Though small, each garden is an excellent example of "borrowed landscaping," where the surrounding mountains and scenery are an integral part of the garden design. Visit the memorable Tokko Heiwa Kaikan, or Peace Museum, dedicated to the young kamikaze pilots who trained near Chiran before embarking on suicide missions against Allied sea vessels in WWII. The museum commemorates the bravery and sad sacrifice of these young Japanese men, and makes a plea for world peace. Return to Kagoshima and the ship following your in-depth visit to Chiran.

KOJ-005 VOLCANIC SAKURAJIMA

OVERVIEW

Discover the natural beauty of volcanic Japan by cruising to Sakurajima, one of the country's most active volcanoes and the beloved symbol of Kagoshima. As you cruise across Kinko Bay, you will be treated to a unique perspective of the volcano, which smokes and erupts almost daily, although fortunately not in a major way. However, an eruption in 1914 was so massive that when the lava flow hardened it bridged the bay, connecting an island just off shore to Osumi Peninsula. Upon arriving at the port, you will visit the Arimura Observatory, which sits atop a volcanic hill formed by another eruption. It is one of the few places in the world where you can safely view a highly active volcano. There are numerous lookout decks that will offer a variety of viewpoints of towering Sakurajima.

OVERVIEW

Discover the exquisite flora at Sengan-en Garden and delve in Kagoshima's industrial history by browsing a museum with artifacts from one of Japan's earliest machinery factories. Both attractions are so spectacular that UNESCO declared them World Heritage sites. The garden is a botanical oasis built to complement the 17th-century residence of one of Japan's most influential feudal lords. It couldn't be lovelier, especially with majestic Mount Sakurajima towering in the background. It surrounds the former villa of the powerful Shimazu clan. A few centuries later, a descendant of the clan built Japan's first Western-style factory in Kagoshima to produce armaments, glass, ceramics and farm tools. You will see some of those artifacts at the Shoko Shuseikan Museum, including personal items from the Shimazu clan and fine Satsuma porcelain. Even the building is significant, as it was the first western-style stone building in Japan with arches.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Stroll through the 17th-century botanical oasis Sengan-en Garden, a World Heritage site.
- See how the garden was built to complement the Shimazu clan's 17th-century residence.
- Browse a museum with artifacts from a factory that a Shimazu clan descendant built.
- Admire the museum structure, Japan's first western-style stone building with arches.

KEE-008 SPIRITUAL NORTH TAIWAN

OVERVIEW

Experience the spiritual side of Taiwan by meditating at a renowned Buddhist retreat, followed by an exploration of Taiwanese artistry at the esteemed Juming Museum. Once you settle in at the Dharma Drum Mountain monasteries and educational center, you will spend an hour or so meditating in a way that encourages spiritual enlightenment. You will also learn about the teachings of the late founder, Master Sheng Yen, who wrote more than 100 books and traveled the world spreading the doctrines of Buddhism in a relevant manner. In time, you will arrive at the Juming Museum, named for the celebrated Taiwanese sculptor Ju Ming. The country's only outdoor sculpture museum, it offers a wonderfully natural, mountainside setting where much of the artist's modern work is displayed. There are also interior spaces devoted to Ju Ming's art. Originally a woodcarver, Ju Ming later applied his skills to media as diverse as stainless steel, ceramics and Styrofoam.

- Meditate with a Buddhist monk at a mountain retreat.
- Discover the remarkable teachings and mission of the retreat's founder.
- Admire outdoor sculptures by the artist Ju Ming at his namesake museum.
- See other works inside, some by Ju Ming, others by Picasso and Andy Warhol.

OVERVIEW

Discover the natural beauty of Taiwan by walking through revered Yangmingshan National Park and then enjoy the relaxing hot springs at a coastal resort. You may also catch sight of a Formosan Blue Magpie, a species of bird only found on Taiwan. that he used as an official state car. You will then visit Longshan Temple, which was founded in 1738 and dedicated to the Buddhist Goddess of Mercy. Although rebuilt numerous times in the wake of natural disasters, the temple is still an architectural treasure. Be sure to notice its sweeping roof decorated with mythical creatures. And what better way to end your tour than with a foot massage? After about 45 minutes in the hands of an accomplished masseuse, your feet will be refreshed and ready for the evening.

KEE-003 KEELUNG & THE NATURAL WONDERS OF YELIU

OVERVIEW

Explore the attractions in and around Keelung, a booming seaport that was the base for Japanese pirates in the 16th century. Your tour will start with an enlightening drive through Chung Cheng Park, which features a towering white statue of Kuan Yin, the Buddhist Goddess of Mercy. Being the biggest statue of a goddess in Southeast Asia, it is quite the spectacle, as are the views from the lush park. More outstanding sights await you at Yehliu Geopark, which stretches across a promontory that juts more than a mile into the sea. Erosion from waves, wind and rain have combined to sculpt fantastic natural shapes out of the park’s sandstone. You may see mushroom-like pedestals, formations shaped like ice cream cones and sedimentary rocks with names that resemble their odd shapes, such as Queen’s Head and Fairy Shoe.

- Hear commentary describing Keelung’s history while driving from attraction to attraction.
- See a towering statue of the Buddhist Goddess of Mercy in Chung Cheng Park.
- Behold one bizarre rock formation after another at Yehliu Geopark.

OVERVIEW

Behold the natural beauty of Shifen Waterfall on the upper reaches of the Keelung River and then write a personal wish on a paper lantern and watch it rise into the sky to be answered. Known as Little Niagara because of its horseshoe shape, the waterfall cascades into a wide pool at the bottom. Although not the highest of waterfalls, Shifen is certainly one of the most majestic, and you will enjoy a spectacular view of it. Later, at Shifen Station, you will have the opportunity to write your thoughts, wishes or prayers on a sky lantern, a biodegradable rice paper lantern illuminated by a candle in the bottom. Once you release it, the candle-powered lantern should rise for nearly 10 minutes, time enough for the lantern to disappear from sight and your wish hopefully to be answered.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Behold the stunning natural beauty of Shifen Waterfall, the broadest waterfall in Taiwan.
- Discover the tradition of releasing sky lanterns into the air.
- Release your own sky lantern in hopes that your wishes written inside will be answered.
