ITINERARY

April 30 Arrive in Dubrovnik and transfer to the Hotel Dubrovnik Palace. Spend the remainder of the day at leisure.

May 1 After breakfast, set out on an inspiring full-day tour of Dubrovnik. Step back in time as you explore the city's historic heart, where iconic landmarks such as St. Blaise's Church, Sponza Palace, and the Dominican Monastery reflect centuries of cultural heritage. Stroll along the cobbled streets beneath the imposing city walls and discover hidden corners steeped in legend. Pause for a traditional lunch at Rudjer, savoring authentic Dalmatian flavors. The experience culminates with a breathtaking cable car ride to Mount Srd, where panoramic views of Dubrovnik's terracotta rooftops, the shimmering Adriatic Sea, and the nearby Elaphiti Islands in the distance.

May 2 After breakfast, embark on a scenic half-day tour to the nearby village of Mali Ston, renowned for its centuries-old oyster farming tradition. Cruise across the tranquil waters of Mali Ston Bay to a family-owned oyster farm, where you'll learn firsthand about the region's time-honored aquaculture techniques. Delight in the opportunity to taste freshly harvested oysters, paired with a glass of local wine, all while surrounded by the bay's peaceful beauty and dramatic coastal scenery. As the tour comes to a close, transfer to *Emerald Kaia* to embark on your Adriatic yachting adventure.

ACTIVITY LEVEL: ACTIVE

Mobility Requirement: Travelers should be confident in their ability to walk and stand for up to 3-4 hours with a total of up to 2 miles per day while keeping a steady pace with a group or tour guide. This tour can involve walking on mostly uneven ground and occasionally stairs, some with no handrails. Guests must be able to enter a small boat for transfer to Oyster Farm. Travelers should be able to board a coach or tour bus independently. This tour is not recommended for those with a walker or a wheelchair.
