MADE IN AMERICA

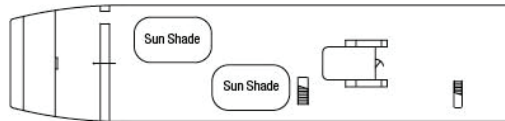

The American Cruise Lines crewmembers bring the ship to life, exploring the U.S. Many of the crew have sailed for years.

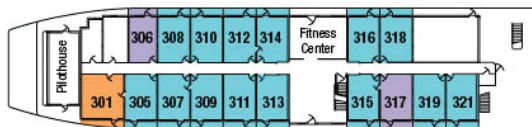

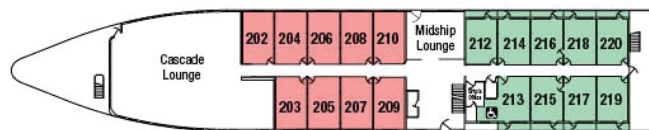
4TH DECK



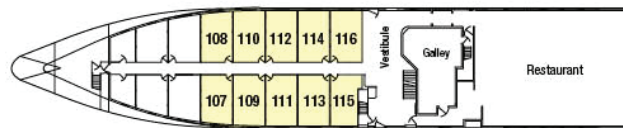
3RD DECK
